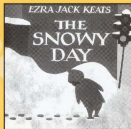

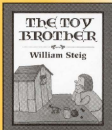
**Don't Leave an Elephant to Go and Chase a Bird**

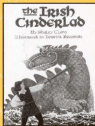
**The Toy Brother**

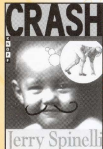
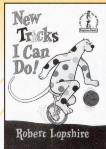
**Now Everybody Really Hates Me**
